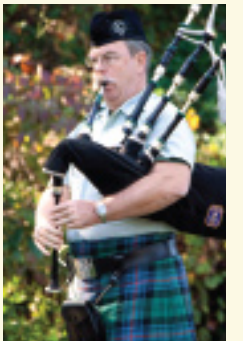

## SPACE ONLY - \$50

## SPACE, TABLES, CHAIRS - \$70

Clan/Society brings their own tent and sets it up in their assigned 10x10 foot space; SCHG provides one table and four chairs. Also includes 2 admission wristbands to the Games, 1 parking pass and 2 tickets to the Saturday night Ceilidh.

## TENT, TABLES, CHAIRS - \$120

SCHG provides one 10x10 foot tent, one table, 4 chairs set up in the assigned space. Also includes 2 admission wristbands to the Games, 1 parking pass and 2 tickets to the Saturday night Ceilidh.

Clan and Society Registrations will be accepted from March 1, 2010 thru September 1, 2010. For guaranteed placement registrations and *payment in full* must be postmarked by September 1, 2010. Applications postmarked after September 1, 2010 will be accepted based on availability of space and tents. Tent space assignments will be made in the order of first come – first served, in accordance with postal date and time along with the completed registration and *payment in full*.

Clans/Societies must have their tents set up *and vehicles must be off the field by 7:30 AM on Saturday, October 2nd*. The gate to the John Blue Complex will be open for set up on Friday, October 1st after 3 p.m. and again on Saturday morning from 6:00 a.m. until 7:30 a.m.
